Provider/Employer delivers training 27 to 33 months


The apprentice will build up a portfolio of evidence

## Gateway to End-Point Assessment -

Employer, Provider and apprentice confirm readiness for EPA including Maths, English and Portfolio requirements

Book EPA via ICME booking process

Gateway - 6 months from the end of on-programme delivery

## Technical Interview supported by portfolio of evidence

10 scenario and competency based questions which are based on the contents of the portfolio

Awarded Fail/Pass/distinction



## **Practical Observation**

A range of substantial and complex tasks assessed by the IEPA Including 10 open questions Awarded Fail/Pass/distinction



ICME Moderation of grades given by IEPA



ICME Final Grade Decision supported by Grade Report from IEPA



## Certification

ICME will apply for the Apprentice certificate through the ESFA. The ESFA aims to issue publically funded certificates within 10 working days of the request.

To be completed within 6 months from meeting gateway requirements
