What is the Diploma and who is it for?

It is a dedicated foundry and casting specific qualification ideal for a range of individuals from those new to the industry, or early career professionals as well as Technicians and Supervisors and anyone aspiring to these roles. If your company has a need to develop employees, this course would be ideal. The Diploma is accredited by Awarding Body, EAL with certification provided upon completion.

The Diploma aims to provide individuals with knowledge and related practical skills in a range of Casting (engineering) subjects covering the following areas:

- Engineering and Environmental Health and Safety
- Engineering Organisational Efficiency and Improvement
- Consumable Mould Casting Processes
- Permanent Mould Casting Processes
- Design for Casting
- Sand Moulding and Core Making
- Processing and Casting of Molten Metal
- Metallurgical Testing

It is delivered through a blend of online exams, tutor delivery sessions and tutorials, written answers, assessed practical work and co-ordinated self-study through a range of support materials.

All those completing the course will receive ICME membership* for the duration of the programme for anyone who is not already a member.

Anyone completing the Diploma may be eligible for registration as an Engineering Technician (on the Engineering Council Register of professional engineers) through ICME.

How is the Diploma delivered?

The Diploma is delivered in 3-day block group delivery sessions with industry tutors over an 18-month duration.

The qualification requires 600 guided learning hours which will be covered through delivery sessions and a small amount of self-directed study.

This qualification is available nationally.

Entry Requirements

There are no formal entry requirements to complete this Diploma qualification. Must have the potential to achieve all aspects of the qualification, including being able to demonstrate a minimum level of literacy and numeracy to be fully compliant with all Health and Safety aspects.
